Trained at Duke for Plastic Surgery, Dr. Wong returned home to Sacramento to join the University of California Davis faculty, serving as Residency Program Director as well as Director of Body Contouring After Weight Loss for over 18 years. Now Emeritus Professor of Surgery at UCD, Dr. Wong is currently Associate Dean of Academic and Career Advising, Vice President of Clinical Practice and Professor of Plastic Surgery at California Northstate University. During this transition from UCD to CNU, Dr. Wong completed his executive MBA at Wharton and joined Prime Plastic Surgery, a practice entity backed by private equity. He currently serves as the Fellowship Director for the Prime Aesthetics Group Fellowship, a national multi-surgeon, multi-site aesthetics fellowship program and practices with Ideal Plastic Surgery, a multi-surgeon group in Sacramento. While President of the California Society of Plastic Surgeons, he led the defeat of the American Board of Cosmetic Surgeons final attempt to gain equivalency in the eyes of the Medical Board of California. He currently serves as the Chair of State Advocacy for the ASPS' Legislative Advocacy Committee.
