

Tae Chong, MD, is a professor and Chief of the Division of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU). His clinical interests include reconstructive microsurgery, surgical management of lymphedema, limb salvage and aberrant scarring/wound healing. He researches clinical outcomes in reconstructive microsurgery with a focus on breast reconstruction. His basic science research currently focuses on keloid pathogenesis and treatment.

Dr. Chong is a board member and past president of the Mountain West Society of Plastic Surgeons. He serves on resident educational committees for the American Society of Plastic Surgeons and American Council of Academic Plastic Surgeons. He is an ad hoc reviewer for Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. Prior to joining VCU, Dr. Chong was the Program Director and Medical Director for plastic surgery at the University of Colorado. He trained in general surgery at the University of Virginia and completed his plastic surgery training at the University of Pittsburgh.
